

Boys Hope Girls HopeCommunity Building Confirmation

Thank you for signing up to volunteer for our Community Building Project at Boys Hope Girls Hope!

<u>Time Commitment</u>: Please do not be late! Your work day is **8:00 a.m.—3:00 p.m.** *sharp!* If you are late or you do not show up, our repair schedule and progress will be significantly delayed.

<u>Location</u>: Boys Hope Girls Hope is located at 1310 Kensington Drive, Fullerton, CA 92831. (see map below). Please carpool if possible. You may park anywhere along the nearby streets but please be respectful of the neighborhood.

Registration: When you arrive on site at 8:00 a.m., please check in with our hospitality volunteers. Depending on the number of volunteers, it may take some time. During registration please turn in your completed Site Specific Liability Form. You also need to make yourself a name tag and sign-in.

<u>Safety Meeting</u>: A welcome, project overview and safety meeting will begin at **8:00 a.m.** The safety meeting is mandatory and if you miss this portion of registration you may not be allowed to build. After the safety meeting, volunteers will be divided up and assigned tasks for the day. Please be flexible and willing to help wherever the need is greatest!

<u>Lunch</u>: We will break for lunch at **12:00 p.m.** for about 45 minutes. Please feel free to bring your own lunch in a small cooler as lunch is not provided by Habitat.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Completed Site Specific Liability Form
- Hat and sunscreen
- Lunch
- Water Bottle (We have water to refill your container throughout the day. We do not provide water containers.)

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Personal tools
- Purse, cell phones, camera (Habitat OC is not responsible for lost or damaged items)

PLEASE WEAR:

- Hard Soled Work boots or Hiking shoes with a non-slip, nail-resistant sole. NO SNEAKERS, TENNIS SHOES OR OPEN-TOED SHOES ARE PERMITTED ON THE BUILD SITE!
- Jeans are preferred; shorts are accepted on hot days.
- If you arrive dressed improperly, we will ask you to change or leave the build site. This is for your own safety.
