CITY OF CHICO ANNOUNCES THE CHICO SPRING CLEAN DAY COMMUNITY CLEAN UP EVENT

(Chico, CA – March 18, 2021 –) The City of Chico is proud to announce The Chico Spring Clean Day, which will be held on Saturday, April 24th from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This community clean up event was inspired by the Chico City Council and will occur Citywide.

Volunteers may sign up to clean in a designated area in the community, such as sections of Bidwell Park or Chico bicycle paths. In addition, they may volunteer in their own neighborhood.

The City of Chico has partnered with CARD (Chico Area Recreation & Park District) to assist with signing up volunteers. Those signing up will be redirected to CARD's Chico Spring Clean Day registration page. From there they may choose to sign up for either the Community Team Clean-Up in designated areas, or in the Neighborhood Clean-Up. Each Community Team Clean-Up area has a description of meeting and debris drop off locations, as well as additional special instructions for that particular area.

"The Chico Spring Clean Day is a great way for Chico to come together in an effort to make our city shine," said Mayor Andrew Coolidge. "From bike paths to parks to our neighborhoods, this community-wide effort is going to be an inspiring and much-needed event!"
