REPORT YOUR MONARCH & MILKWEED OBSERVATIONS TO JOURNEY NORTH JULY 23–AUGUST 1




MONARCH ADULT SIGHTED

- **What?** Number of adult monarchs observed during a single sighting.
- **How often?** One observation per location during the week of July 23–August 1.
- **Photos Needed?** Yes, please upload one photo with your report.
- **Comments?** Tell us what behavior you observed; for example, flying, nectaring, basking in the sun, etc.

MONARCH EGGS AND LARVAE

- **What?** Presence of monarch eggs and larvae observed. No need to count eggs or larvae but, if you do, please place this info in the number field.
- **How often?** One observation per location during the week of July 23–August 1.
- **Photos Needed?** Yes, please upload one photo with your report.
- **Comments?** Tell us what milkweed species hosted the eggs and larvae.



MILKWEED

- **What?** Presence of milkweed observed. You do not need to count stems but, if you do, please place this info in the number field.
- **How often?** One observation per location during the week of July 23–August 1.
- **Photos Needed?** Yes, please upload one photo with your report.
- **Comments?** Tell us what milkweed species you observed.
