

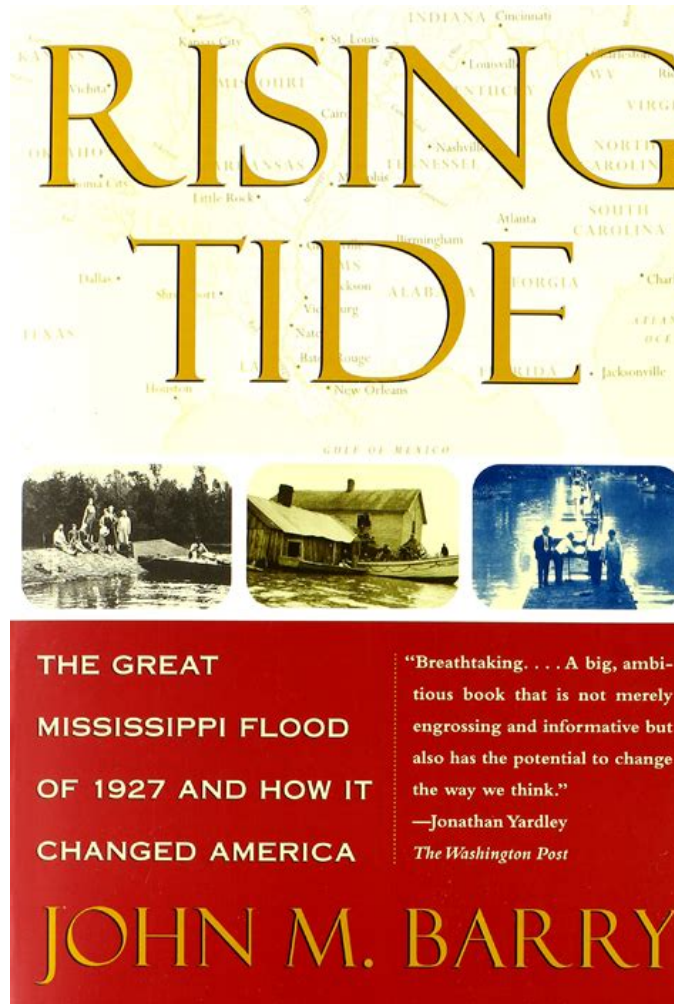
## *Louisiana Natural History Book Group*
