- Maintaining a safe environment for the children, including one that includes no bullying
- Encourage practice outside of tutoring sessions
- Maintain communication with the volunteer coordinator
- Log all volunteer time in Track it Forward

- Ability to work with people from different cultures and with limited English proficiency
- Willingness to follow conversation instructions from OACES ESL Teachers
- Patience, dependable, responsible, flexibility, and understanding
- Ability to exhibit professionalism
- Must be at least 18 years of age
