TIME COMMITTMENT: Mondays. Tuesdays, Wednesdays and/or Thursdays from *4:30 – 7PM (*if you can't arrive until 5:00pm, that is okay)! Volunteers choose the day(s) based on their availability.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Being responsible for supervising and actively engaging with children of various ages in recreational activities, arts and crafts, group games and creative play.
- Helping children discover new interests by introducing them to art, music, sports, and other potential hobbies.
- Providing guidance or approved discipline, as needed.
- Maintaining a safe environment for the children, including one that includes no bullying
- Maintain communication with the volunteer coordinator
- Log all volunteer time in Track it Forward

- Ability to work with people from different cultures and with limited English proficiency
- Willingness to follow conversation instructions from OACES ESL Teachers
- Patience, dependable, responsible, flexibility, and understanding
- Ability to exhibit professionalism
- Must be at least 18 years of age
