

Reading POD: Lailah's Lunch Box

Warmer: Talk to the kids as they come in. Ask them how Ramadan is going and how they feel that it will be ending soon. What has been the hardest part of Ramadan? Warmer game: have the kids narrate a story to the class either something really funny, sad, or exciting that has happened to them. Coaches go first to give the kids an idea. Add in as much detail and emotion as you can. If the kids cannot think of anything, have them do a movie scene or even a book they have read.

Reading 1: First coach reads the story to the students

Reading 2: Reading Freeze- Have the kids pick out their favorite color/fruit/food/silly word etc.








- Have the kids say their favorite color/fruit/food/silly word etc. whenever lunchbox is mentioned in the book

Student reading: students take turns reading each page.








- When the students struggle give them a second to work out the word for themselves before helping them.
