**Who:** Blessed Carlo Acutis, an Italian teenager who passed away from cancer but had a sincere devotion to the Eucharist and a passion for research. Carlo Acutis attended a Jesuit high school in Milan. He was a kind person who spoke up for bullied children and helped his friends whose parents were separating. He volunteered his time with the underprivileged and destitute outside of school. He was regarded as a "computer geek" who had a deep devotion to the Eucharist. He died of leukemia in 2006 and was beatified in 2020.

**What:** This exhibition features a wide range of images and historical summaries of the various Eucharist miracles that occurred across the world and were acknowledged by the Catholic Church. Discover the International Exhibit of Eucharistic Miracles organized by Blessed Carlo Acutis that catalogs Eucharistic miracles from around the world. The exhibition offers visitors the chance to learn more about Blessed Carlo Acutis, expand their knowledge of Eucharistic miracles, and develop a unique connection to the Eucharist.
