

RENDEZVOUS 2022 Friday, April 1, 2022 – Sunday, April 3, 2022 Conserving Louisiana's Natural Heritage

The Louisiana Master Naturalist Association (LMNA) is pleased to announce the 6th Annual Rendezvous, a statewide meeting of the seven master naturalist chapters in Louisiana, including Acadiana (Lafayette), Greater Baton Rouge, Northeast Louisiana (Monroe), Northwest Louisiana (Shreveport/Bossier), Greater New Orleans, and Southwest Louisiana (Lake Charles) and Central Louisiana (Alexandria). WHAT: Rendezvous 2022 will include talks on a variety of natural history subjects, guided naturalist hikes, photography contest, a silent auction, book sales, and time to be friend other master naturalists.

WHEN: Rendezvous 2022 will take place from Friday, April 1, 2022 through Sunday, April 3, 2022. Speakers and field trips will be scheduled from late Friday afternoon through Sunday morning. Program details will be released as they are finalized.

WHO: The event is open to Louisiana Master Naturalists and their spouses/partners. Chapter members that are enrolled in classes to earn certification are also included. Due to current pandemic conditions, all attendees of 2022 Rendezvous will require proof of Covid vaccinations.

WHERE: Pineville Conference Center is adjacent to Country Inn and Suites, north of Alexandria. Excursions will be made to Camp Hardtner and Kisatchie National Forest (drive your own vehicle, each approximately 20 minutes away)

ACCOMMODATIONS: The Country Inn and Suites have reserved a block of rooms for LMNA. Rate is \$89 - \$99 for a double room or a suite. Hotel reservations are made on your own – separate from your conference registration. (Call 318-641-8332)

REGISTRATION COST: \$100 per person includes lunch and dinner on Saturday. Optional add-on dinner Friday night (5:30 – 6:30 PM) at the Conference Center for \$25. (Hotel provides breakfast for hotel-registered guests)

CANCELLATION POLICY: Please keep in mind that we reserve meeting rooms, plan menus with the caterer, and schedule workshops and field trips based on the number of attendees. We hope that you will not need to cancel your Rendezvous plans. We can only refund cancellations to the extent that these do not cost LMNA.

Up to March 1st - full refund minus a \$5.00 processing cost.

March 2 - March 18 - 50% refund

March 19 and after - no refunds, unless LMNA Board approves exceptions
