Check-in instructions

- · Please enter the school by the <u>upper gate</u> next to the administration building.
- Only volunteers with confirmed shifts will be permitted to enter without purchasing a ticket. Please check in for volunteer duty at the gate.
- Next, head to the location where you will be working. For example, if you are working concessions, please check in at the concessions booth that you have signed up for. All Security check-ins are at Room 404 in the administration building.

Expectations
